

GC32 Int. Class Association

circular resolution / 18.11.2015 / results

The members of the GC32 Int. Class Association have voted in the circular resolution from the 18th of November 2015 in favour of the following three motions below about a track system on the mast, a optional snubber winch and an additional equal gennaker for the yearly racing sails inventory.

These three motions have been all accepted with an at least 2/3 majority of the votes.

The Builder Specifications / Class Rules of the GC32 Int. Class Association shall be amended as follows:

1. Antal mast track and slider system for mainsail

Changing the current boltrope system to the Antal mast track and slider system using the Antal HS22 track system with 6 batten and 5 intermediate cars. For this change mast and mainsails will have to be modified.

Cost Antal mast track hardware:	€ 3'150 ex VAT
Estimated costs labour mast (approx. 80 hours):	€ 4'000 ex VAT
Estimated costs material and paint:	€ 500 ex VAT
Estimated costs modification existing mainsail:	€ 500 ex VAT
Cost Antal hardware modification existing mainsail: (Only batten boxes no cars)	€ 650 ex VAT
Estimated total costs for the change:	€ 8'800 ex VAT

New mainsails 2016 will be delivered from North Sails France with the new system and hardware at no extra cost if this change is accepted.

This modification will be mandatory.

2. Snubber Winch

Add a snubber winch on each hull to use as break for the board down line. The snubber winch will be positioned in the vicinity of the forward Harken winch and board down line jammer.

Cost for a set (two) custom snubber winches: (Including carbon back plate and web)	€ 1555 ex VAT
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This change will be optional.

3. Sails limitations / Amendment of article C.10.2 in the GC32 Class Rules

Adding a second (equal) gennaker to the annual racing sail inventory for the GC32 Racing Tour.

Article C.10.2 (c) shall be amended as follows: *"Not more than 1 mainsails, 2 jibs and 2 equal gennakers shall be used per calendar year for racing in one GC32 Regatta Series."*

Delete Article C.10.2 (d)
