

## **GC32 CLASS RULES 2018 V 1.7 - Questions and Answers No 4**

These Q&A is given in accordance with the GC32 Class Rules 2018 V1.7

### **Question 1:**

Is it permitted to bond a tube inside the beam?

### **Answer 1:**

No, it is not permitted to bond a tube. It is permitted to glue a ring inside a beam as long as it is not changing any sheeting angle or the purpose of any equipment (see C6.1(c)). Such a ring cannot be laminated to the beam.

### **Question 2:**

Is it permitted to do a fairing between the spine cables next to the kingpost?

### **Answer 2:**

No, a fairing is not allowed according to C6.1(a), C10.1 and D3.1. It is only permitted to use tape up to 50 mm on both sides of the kingpost and/or to put a bungy between the cables to avoid trapping seaweed.

### **Question 3:**

Is it permitted to modify the batten receptacle to allow the car to screw in further?

### **Answer 3:**

No it is not permitted to modify or customise a batten receptacle.
